<p>Lectures are conducted online using Google Classroom. This course provides material related to four (4) language skills including <i>dokkai</i> (reading comprehension), <i>kaiwa</i> (speaking), <i>sakubun</i> (writing), and <i>choukai</i> (listening). In addition, <i>honyaku</i> (translation) material is also provided to complement the learner's ability to convey the contents of a discourse. The achievement target in this course is equivalent to Japanese language proficiency at N3 level.
