

GRADUATES PROFILE OF JAPANESE LANGUAGE EDUCATION STUDY PROGRAM


From the current data records, since 1981 the Japanese Language Education Department FPBS UPI has graduated 1,891 graduates.




From the results of the tracer study, in general the graduates of the Japanese Language Education Department FPBS UPI spent their study period between 8 and 10 semesters.




The majority of graduates stated that they currently are employed or are entrepreneurial, with an average waiting period after graduation to get the first job under three months.




Graduates have a wide variety of occupations. Most of them work in the private sector. Most of the others have a teaching profession, either as teachers in schools, or as instructors in course institutions.



37,3% of tracer study respondents who are graduates of the Japanese Language Education Department FPBS UPI stated that they work at national level agencies, 26,9% work at international level agencies, and 24,5% work at local/regional level agencies.



In terms of relevance, 55,9% of graduates stated that the Japanese field of study has high relevance to their work, 29,4% stated moderate relevance, and 14,7% stated low relevance.
