<b>Learning outcomes</b>					
<p>In this Chujokyu Choukai 2 course, students are expected to be able to listen and understand information in Japanese society through audio (CD). The material given in this lecture is equivalent to the N3 level on the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (<i>Nihongo Noryoku Shiken</i>). In this Chujokyu Choukai 2 lecture, the teacher explains things related to learning materials such as vocabulary explanations and expressions used in CD narration. This course is held for 14 meetings, followed by Mid-Semester Examination and End-Semester Examination, with a communicative approach in the form of information gap activities, discussions, question-and-answer exercises, and others. The main source book used as a guide in this course is “Chuukyuu Nihongo Onseikyouzai Shin Mainichi no Kikitori 40 nichi plus (jo &amp; ge)”.</p>
