Learning outcomes					
<p>The subject aims for students to understand and master grammatical materials with a difficulty level equal to N4 of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test. Classes are organized into 14 class sessions with mid-semester examination and end semester examination. The subject can be taken by students who completed Chukyu Bunpo 1. Classes are carried out using methods such as grammar practices, questions and answers, and other methods as well. At the beginning of the subject, students are provided with explanations related to learning materials for the semester. During class, teachers elaborate on things related to learning materials such as vocabularies, sentence patterns, and phrases in Japanese language. The subject requires students to have minimum 80% attendance and fulfil daily assignments in the form of <i>renshuu</i> (practice) and <i>goi</i> (vocabularies) translation, as well as a final assignment in the form of learning materials summary report. Assessment criteria is based on attendance, result of mid-semester and end semester exams, as well as assignments both daily assignments and final assignments. The main textbook used is Chukyu Bunpo textbook from the Japanese language Education Department</p>
