Learning outcomes					
<p>This course is a compulsory subject for students and an advancement of Chukyu Hyoki 1 which emphasizes 140 kanji found in N4-N3 level of Japanese Language Proficiency Test. The discussion emphasizes <i>kun yomi</i> and <i>on yomi</i> reading skills, writing kanji skills according to the order, and its applications to vocabularies, narrations, and writings. It also provides basic knowledge about kanji elements (<i>bushu</i>). This course is held 14 times followed by Mid-Semester Examination and End-Semester Examination.</p>
