<p>This course aims to guide students to be able to understand and master listening material which is equivalent to the N5 level of Japanese language proficiency test. This course is held in 16 meetings consisting of 14 times of lectures, Mid-Semester Examination, and End Semester Examination, discussing matters related to learning materials such as the use of vocabulary, Japanese phrases, and listening methods that are played on a CD. this lecture uses a communicative approach in the form of questions and answers and practice doing daily assignments.
